CPS HR Consulting has been contracted by the CA Department of Public Health (CDPH) to provide transcript evaluation services for the Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) program, Options I-IV. Please See EHS Application Instructions Option I-IV for application instructions.

Effective January, 2013, Option V applicants who possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree in Environmental Health from an institution approved by the Registration Committee should contact CDPH directly. Before being allowed to sit for the exam, Option V applicants will be required to submit the following to CDPH:

1. A letter from the REHS Program Coordinator at the approved institution
2. Official transcripts for all colleges with applicable math or science courses
3. An official degree-posted transcript reflecting the degree conferred
